Schedule Structure

MATH Course Selections

- Incoming 9th graders will either take Algebra 1, Honors Algebra 1, or Honors Geometry.
- In order to take Honors Geometry, students **MUST** currently be taking Algebra 1 (not pre-algebra) and must **SUCCESSFULLY** complete Algebra 1 with a B or higher, achieve an 80% or better on the Algebra 1 Final Exam, as well as have your teacher's recommendation!
- Honors Algebra 1 is for those students who may not have traditionally taken harder math or feel they are not challenged in math. It moves at a faster pace than regular Algebra with less time for practice between skills. It is easier to start out harder and drop down, than to start easy and switch to honors later!




Important Things to Remember with the Scheduling Cards...
